

2011 INSHALLA MATCH PLAY LEAGUE RULES

1. U.S.G.A. Match Play rules apply, except where amended herein:
 - A. Matches consist of 9 holes.
 - B. Winter Rules are observed in fairway of hole being played only.
 - C. Conceded Holes are permissible; see Rule 8 for scoring of Conceded Hole.
 - D. Rule 10-1c, Order of Play – Playing Out of Turn. In respect for PACE OF PLAY there will be no penalty for playing out of turn.
 - E. Note: In most cases the penalty for the breach of a rule is Loss of Hole, please be familiar with the USGA rules.
2. Each match is competing for Individual Points (9) and Team Points (1).
 - A. Individual Points (9). 1 Point per hole awarded to the player with the lower score on the hole. Half points will be awarded in the case of a tie.
 - B. Team Points (1). 1 Point awarded to the player with the most Individual Points in the match. In the event of a tie both players will receive ½.
 - C. Team Night (2 & 4).
 - a. Must be played at scheduled tee time (4:30).
 - b. 2 Individual points per player/sub that plays.
 - c. 1 Team Point per player/sub for the team that plays.
3. League nights will consist of (5) Foursomes:
 - A. Flight Matches – 1 Each of A, B, C, & D
 - B. Team Night – Teams will play together at 4:30 and are responsible for nightly Par/Birdie/Eagle Pot & Skins Games Sheet.
4. Cell phones must be in silent/vibrate mode. If your cell phone rings during a match, the first occurrence is a warning, each occurrence following will result in loss of hole being played.
5. If you must be absent you may (with timely notification):
 - A. Reschedule your match to be played outside of league:
 - a. One week prior to the scheduled match.
 - b. Or completed prior to first scheduled match of the following week.
 - B. Enlist a substitute from your flight.
 - a. Substitutes should be picked from the substitute list first.
 - b. And then from Inshalla league rosters. The substitute's average as of that week will be used and must fit into the division average band.(Subs compete in all games entered)
 - C. Forfeit Match. Forfeiture will result in a score of 5-0.
6. Matches played outside of league night will not be eligible for Par/Birdie/Eagle Pot & Skins Games. Players can play on the scheduled Monday night to be eligible for Par/Birdie/Eagle Pot & Skins Games, but the score will not be counted towards league average.
7. Men will play from the Blue and Women from the White, except under the following conditions:
 - A. Men age 60-69 may move to the White and Women to the Red, if in the last year his/her stroke average causes the player to move down a division (out of division score range.) If player chooses to move forward the player remains in previous year's division.
 - B. Men age 70 and above may move to the Red, if in the last year his stroke average causes him to move down a division (out of division score range.) If player chooses to move forward the player remains in previous year's division.
 - C. Once the choice to move up is made it cannot be reversed without a league vote.
8. Conceded / Unfinished Hole - If a player does not finish a hole or is conceded a stroke, record the most likely score for handicap purposes. A most likely score is the number of strokes already taken, plus in the player's best judgment, the number of strokes needed to complete the hole from that point more than half the time.
9. Equitable Stroke Control will be used in posting scores.

10. In the case of play termination due to weather, if more than 1/2 matches are completed the unfinished matches will half the remaining holes, and players average score by hole will be used to complete round for team score. If 1/2 or less are completed all matches will be rescheduled.
11. 2010 total stroke average determines 2011 player positions.
12. Review Committee:
 - A. Andy Hein, John Hein, Howard Radank, Steve Laskowski
 - B. John Hale (Tie Break)
13. AB Eagle (5) / Birdie (1) Pot, CD Birdie (5) / Par (1) Pot and Weekly Flight Skins Game may be wagered for \$15 each for the season. Skins may be entered at later date prorated. Winners will be tallied each week and monies paid out at end of year banquet.
14. There will be two gimmick flags per evening. Each flag is played for an \$11.00 proshop certificate.
15. A player may not move down (i.e. A-C) more than 1 division per year.
16. Each player is responsible for attesting scorecard promptly at end of play. The person scoring is responsible for getting scores entered into the league computer.
17. In lightning conditions, a player choosing not to complete a round may take hole stroke average to complete scorecard.
18. \$45.00 dues: Pays for Team Plaque and Individual Hat Awards, end of year banquet, 2 \$11 flag events per regular schedule match and scoring fee. Dues are due the first week of play. Individual points may be forfeited for unpaid dues. Team points are unaffected, and opponent points do not change.
19. Hole in ones will pay out \$150.00 (hole in one assessment cancelled) Remaining funds and other account monies will be rolled into hole in one account.
